# Beginnings

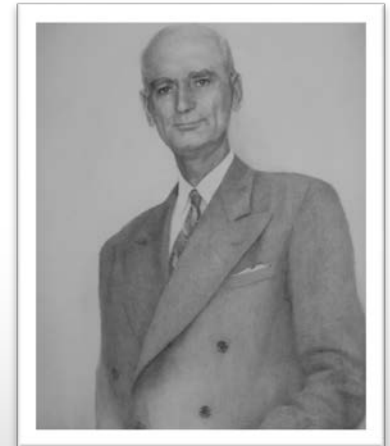
- ▶ Established August 8, 1908 in Port Orchard, WA
- ▶ Founded By: Jacob Furth, a Seattle Financier, and three Port Orchard men, George E. Miller, Peter Nordby and John B Yakey.
- ▶ First President: Peter Nordby  
Second President: Thomas Ross  
Third President: Otto Strizek



# Investing In The Future

## Frank Langer

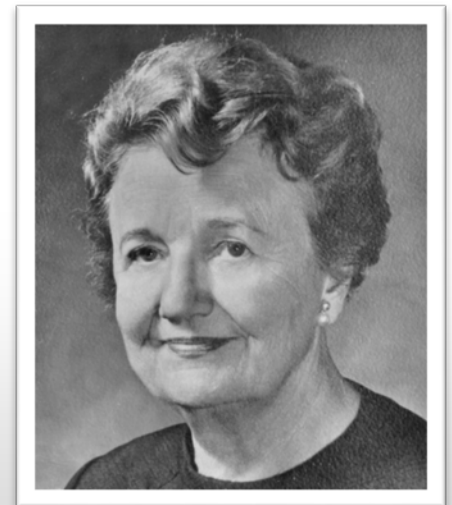
- ▶ Purchased controlling interests of Kitsap County Bank and First National Bank of Poulsbo in 1922
- ▶ Became Kitsap County Bank's 4<sup>th</sup> President in 1930, and served until his death in 1952
- ▶ Lead the bank through The Depression – with the help of depositors



# Breaking New Ground

## **Hannah Langer**

- ▶ Approached to sell the bank upon Frank's death
- ▶ Banking in her blood – Mother took “deposits” during the Klondike Gold Rush
- ▶ First Female Bank President West of the Mississippi River
- ▶ 5<sup>th</sup> President: 1952 – 1972
- ▶ Chairman: 1972 - 1986
