



CYBER TABLETOP EXERCISE

JANUARY 25, 2023 • 9 AM TO 3 PM • VIRTUAL EVENT

Join us for a unique cybersecurity event brought to you by NUARI and the Washington Bankers Association.

This tabletop exercise will allow your organization to see procedures in action and provide valuable feedback to your employees. Washington State Department of Financial Institutions will participate in this event. All participating institutions will be fully anonymized and no institution-specific data will be shared.

The Situation

Washington State has a significant military presence and is home to one of the largest nuclear arsenals in the world. This tabletop exercise will simulate a Russian cybersecurity attack against the entire financial institutional infrastructure in the state.

Russia aims to accomplish two outcomes;

- To make financial transactions impossible for ordinary citizens in the state
- To use the fallout of the attack to turn US military contractors in WA state into threat actors on behalf of Russia

The outcomes for participating institutions are:

- To understand and gain insight into the threat profile your institution has, especially in the face of a hostile nation
- To test your planned response to the Computer-Security Incident Notification Rule
- To gain "real world" insight into your policies and procedures dealing with cyber breaches and response, and develop mitigation/improvement steps
- **NO ADDITIONAL REGULATORY SCRUTINY** will result from participation
